

## NOTICE TO MARINERS No 33 (T) of 2024

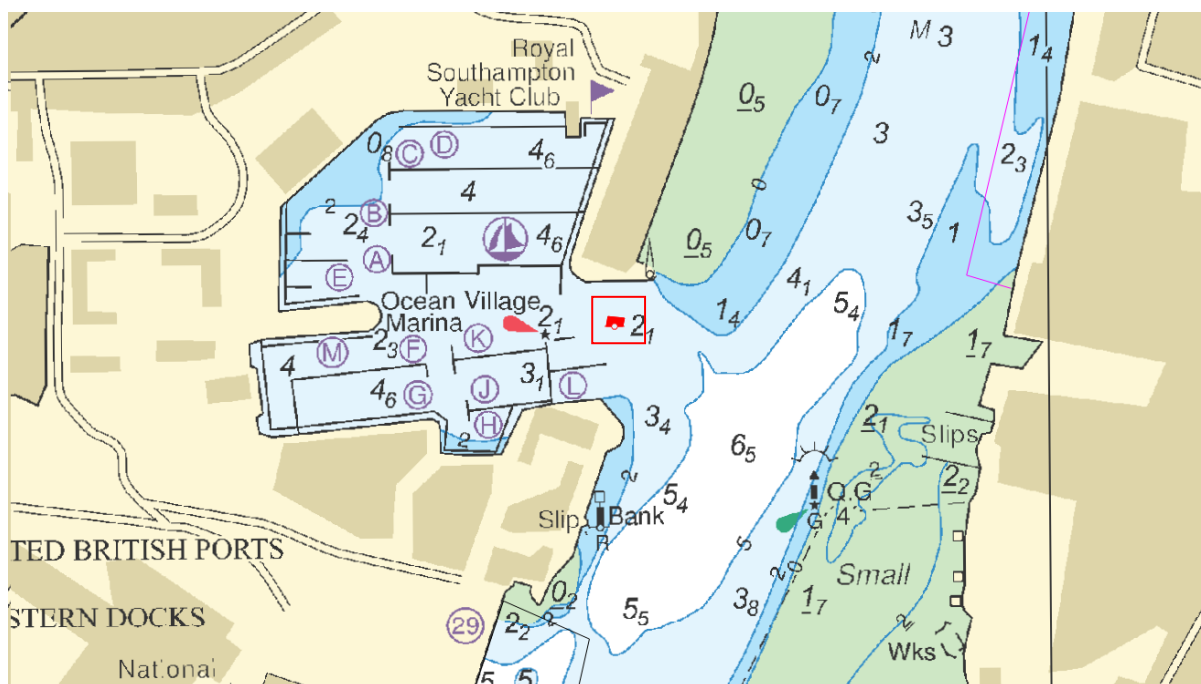
### Port of Southampton – Ocean Village South Side Pontoons replacement works

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Ocean Village marina, located on the River Itchen, will be conducting maintenance works to its pontoons and piling within the Southern Water space of the site. Works are due to commence on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> November 2023 and are expected to last until March 2024. Dredging is expected to start on the 4<sup>th</sup> December 2023 and complete by 27<sup>th</sup> January 2024.

Works will involve the sequenced removal and direct replacement of pontoons and piles, with dredging of the water space in between also to occur whilst pontoons are off station.

Works will be carried out Monday to Saturday 0800 - 1800 from a Walcon Marine floating plant. Dredging will be completed using a backhoe dredger and Split hopper barges (details tbc).

A red port hand mark will be placed temporarily in the entrance to Ocean village to mark the edge of the entrance. The buoy will be in position: 50° 53.705' N 001° 23.310' W as shown below:



All vessels involved with the works will be maintaining a listening watch on VHF Ch12 and will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.

Mariners are requested to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the works, allowing wide berth and minimum wash where practicable. If required, additional information can be requested from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.
